Help Save Lives/FAB First Aid Safeguarding Policy

Mission Statement/Introduction

Help Save Lives mission is to make sure every child who attends our classes feels safe, secure and relaxed.

Safeguarding Training

All Help Save Lives staff will have completed a certificated course including introduction to Safeguarding/Working with Children.

Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check

All staff at Help Save Lives will have a full and valid DBS check, which is regularly updated through the DBS Update Service. All Help Save Lives staff will present this to the school upon arrival along with photo identification

Photography

No photographs or photographic recording of children will to be taken using a personal mobile, phone device or other recording equipment (such as a camera) in schools.

Help Save Lives will only use the photography on social media when a school we have trained share any images or video's on our own social media platforms and have given us permission.

Child Concern

If a Help Save Lives member of staff are concerned about any child within the FAB First Aid class they will inform a member of staff preferable one of the safeguarding team at the school.

Medical Needs

All Help Save Lives staff are First Aid trained. If any child attending FAB First Aid class have any medical needs – physically or mentally we ask the school to let us know
